Penny and the Far Thing

Street performance

Penny and the Far Thing is a small 20 minute outdoor puppet performance for all ages. The performers tell a story to a relatively small audience (depending on venue / space, approx. 20 – 60 people) using a small penny farthing bicycle as their stage. All puppets and props come out of a small wooden box that is fix on the front of the penny farthing. The performing company consists of two performers.
